Which Came First?



Many people know that I have started getting eggs from my chickens again. I have a beautiful new flock of young hens just getting good and warmed up on their egg laying (at least they will be when the weather warms up a little). I have 19 hens (4 White Leghorns – white eggs, 4 Buff Orpingtons – very light brown eggs, 4 Rhode Island Reds – brown eggs, 4 Barr Rock – brown eggs, and three Araucanas – green eggs) and one pretty New Hampshire Red rooster keeping all the girls in line.

So, now I have a problem. What to do with the 12 to 15 eggs a day I get. Here's my plan: every Sunday I will bring the eggs I have that week to church and leave them in the refrigerator in the kitchen. Around the eggs will be a container for money. I will not set a price for the eggs, just pay as you wish. Half of the income from the egg sales I will donate to the Heifer Project International. The other half will help me offset my feed costs.

Enjoy the eggs!
